

School Attire: Dress for Success

Students express their individuality through clothing and dress. Our dress code is simple: come to school well groomed, neatly dressed and ready to learn. Questionable attire will be referred to our principal or assistant principal, and students will be asked to change into their PE uniforms or parents may be called to bring in a change of clothing.

As per CHCCS Policy Code 4315 Orderly Environment the following is prohibited: *appearance or clothing which*

- (1) violates the reasonable dress code adopted and publicized by the school,*
- (2) is substantially disruptive, or (3) is provocative or obscene; or*
- (4) endangers the health or safety of the student or others;*

The following items are best worn at home, on the weekend or at the beach - not at school:

- pajamas; all sleepwear and bedtime accessories are prohibited
- bedroom shoes
- exposed undergarments / boxer shorts / sports bras
- distracting or revealing clothing
(e.g. low sagging pants, short shorts / skirts, halter / midriff tops, spaghetti-strap tops)
- hemlines of shorts above fingertips when arms are by your side
- skull / wave / stocking caps / “do rags”
- hats and hoodies; all headgear should be removed when entering the building
- bandanas
- gang attire / gang symbols
- “rock star” style belts with studs
- spiked accessories and chains; including those attached to wallets, belt loops & jewelry
- articles with messages of profanity, hatred, violence, the use of drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, sexual overtones, gang association or weapons of any kind.
